## **Seventh Grade American History**

In seventh grade, students will study American history using a thematic approach. The year will start with an overview of American history, providing students with a basic outline of events. After establishing a solid framework for American History, students will begin exploring themes that have re-occurred throughout our nation's history. Students will study each theme using both primary and secondary sources and learn the connections between history and events today. In eighth grades, students will continue their study of American focusing on new themes such as civil rights, foreign relations, economic development, et al.
